EMPLOYMENT DETAILS

The Koinonia Men's Mission Leader is responsible for leading Koinonia's mission on the ground, caring for the men in Koinonia, managing the student outreach teams, participating in Koinonia's evangelistic work, being a proactive member of the staff team, and praying for the work.

He is accountable to the Director of Koinonia.

Salary will be in the range of £6.95 (minimum wage) to £9.75 (London living wage) per hour based on experience.

This is a 30 hr / week position.

Start Date: 15th July 2017

End Date: 13th July 2019 (with option to extend if all parties agree).

Given the nature of the work we operate a 3 month notice period for both Koinonia and the employee.

The candidate is required to have permission to work in the UK

JOB PURPOSE

From the basis of a personal relationship and knowledge of God this job requires the successful candidate to:

- Evangelise: Build a core of students where relationship with God can be discovered.
- Disciple: Build an environment where students can grow in faith and discipleship.
- Build Community: Foster love, knowledge, commitment and service of the Lord and one another amongst Koinonia students.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The successful candidate will

- Lead a Men's household if required.
- Lead and oversee small groups.
- Oversee male student missionaries.
- Review and monitor Student Programme with Women's Mission Leader(s) to help implement the programme more effectively.
- Oversee and initiate men's evangelism.

- Willingness to grow spiritually, receive formation and teaching and receive pastoral care themselves from a pastoral leader.
